You would become the teen's Foster Provider (i.e. Foster Parent) and welcome them into your home, providing the care and guidance that they require. As the youth becomes an adult, you would work with them as their Adult Home Provider. This important step for adolescents with challenging needs is so crucial to their future success. When the adolescent in your home becomes an adult, you would be able to continue to provide care through the Adult Disabilities Waiver Program.

When foster youth "step down" out of residential care, your home will provide the stability they need to transition to adulthood while supporting individual goals, interests and skills to help promote them to live full independent and productive lives.

- Accommodation with your schedule through the foster care licensing process working as a team to make it happen
