There are a variety of ways you can get vaccinated whether you have health insurance or not. Check out the various ways below...

If you **HAVE** health insurance (including Medicare, Medicaid, & CHP+), it should cover the cost of the vaccine if your provider takes your insurance. You can get a COVID-19 or flu vaccine at:

If you **DO NOT HAVE** insurance or your insurance does not cover the costs of vaccinations, you can still get vaccinated at low or no cost. You can get a low or no cost COVID-19 or flu vaccine at:

- [Vaccines for Children Program](#)
 - Provides vaccines for children who are uninsured, underinsured, on Medicaid or Medicaid-eligible, and/or Alaskan Native/American Indian.
 - Some Vaccines for Children Providers may also have low and no cost vaccines for uninsured and underinsured adults aged 19 and older.

- Find a Local HRSA-supported Health Center
- [HRSA-supported health centers](#) provide care to patients regardless of their ability to pay approximately 15,000 sites across the country. Most health centers have 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccines available and adjust their fees based on income and family size.
- Use the [online tool](#) to find a health center near you.

Please note, you can still go to a local pharmacy or retail shop and receive immunizations without insurance, but there will likely be costs associated with the vaccines.
